They leave a trail of breadcrumbs behind them so they do not go along the same path twice.

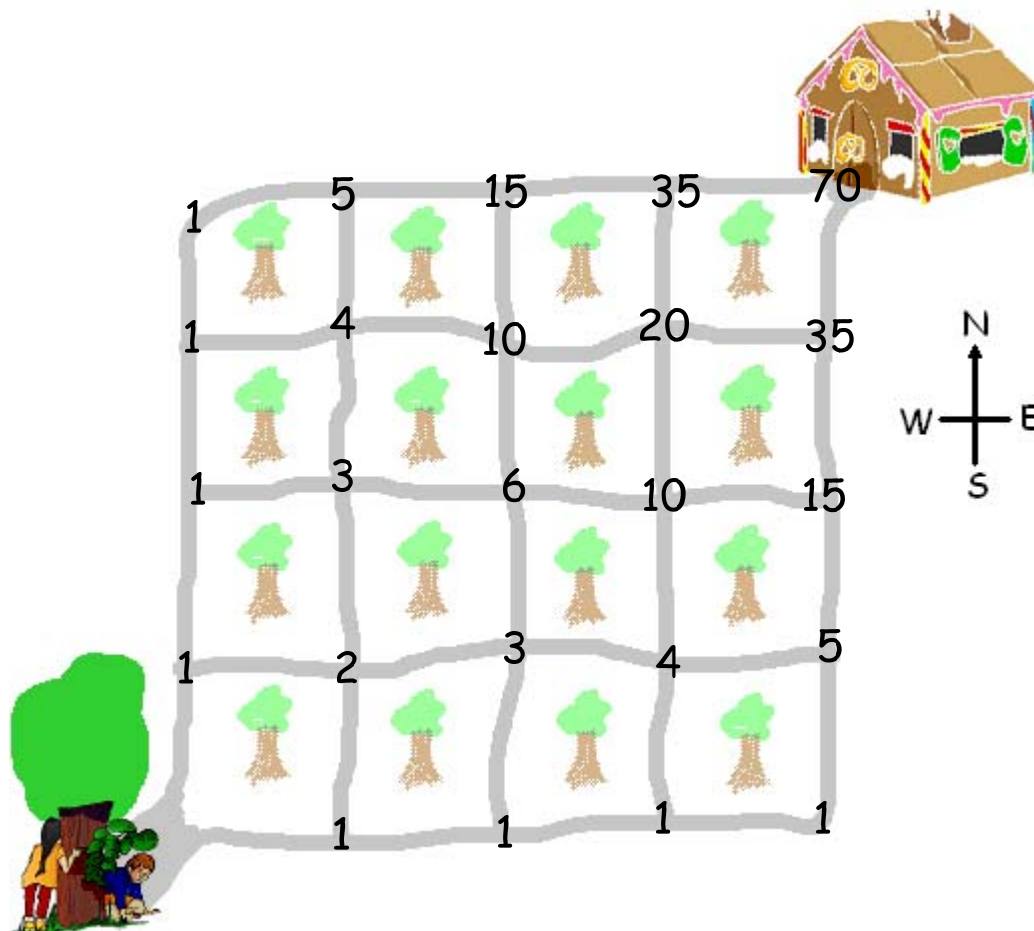


How many routes are there through the wood to the Gingerbread House?

- Use a systematic approach to solve the problem

Babes in the Wood Solution:



Use a systematic approach to work out how many routes there are to each intersection of paths.

From the patterns that arise predict the final number of paths which would be too difficult to count with confidence.
