### **Kent School Green Day Champions**

We are delighted that you are interested in becoming a Kent School Green Day Champion by attending the CFE / CABE training event on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2010. This is a funded opportunity for all with supply costs included for those Kent schools who go on to act as LLN champions and lead their area on the Green Day Project in 2011.

This is being organised as a two year development supported by the Commission for Architecture and the Built Environment (CABE) trainers and KCC Advisors and Officers and provides schools with an opportunity to bid for some CABE / English Heritage funding.

In the first year we are asking each of the LLN area Champions in both the Primary and Secondary Phases to nominate a lead teacher and a member of the School Leadership Team to attend the 31<sup>st</sup> March 2010 session. CABE will train each of the Local Learning Network (LLN) Area Champions to enable each to pilot a CABE Green Day event in their school during the summer season (Term 6) 2010. During this training day, we will also explore how the Local Authority can support schools in their Eco School developments. For information, all schools are expected to be sustainable schools by 2020.

In the second year the LLN Area Green Day Champions will organise training for schools in their areas (supported by a cross directorate group and CABE trainer) to extend the event across both Primary and Secondary schools for their LLN.
