Participants will have an opportunity to: analyse and interpret a range of data on pupil attainment, work on-line using their own school's RAISEonline data to evaluate attainment and progress of vulnerable groups, investigate question level analysis (Gap Analysis) to identify gaps in Teaching & Learning, and focus in on vulnerable groups and pupils as well as gaining an overall school picture.

## Supporting Pupils with Physical Impairments

*This is a foundation level course designed for those who are currently supporting children and young people with physical impairments. The aim is to raise awareness of general disability issues and to provide practical ideas to help remove the barriers to learning and assessment. The course will take place over 3 full day sessions with short written tasks between sessions. The third day will concentrate on Information Communication Technology access. Delegates will have the opportunity to learn how to use specific software and access devices to enable them to include pupils with physical impairment. A combination of practical activities, discussion, and media presentations will make up the course.*
