**Security Policy**

A connection to the Kent Community Network and the Internet brings great educational opportunities, but also requires careful attention to the safety and security of pupils, staff and the ICT systems. **Bandwidth Options**

From April 1<sup>st</sup> 2008, the secondary school contribution would have been £10,609 for a 10 Mbps connection. Cluster host schools have connections to local primary schools or other units often via wireless links.
