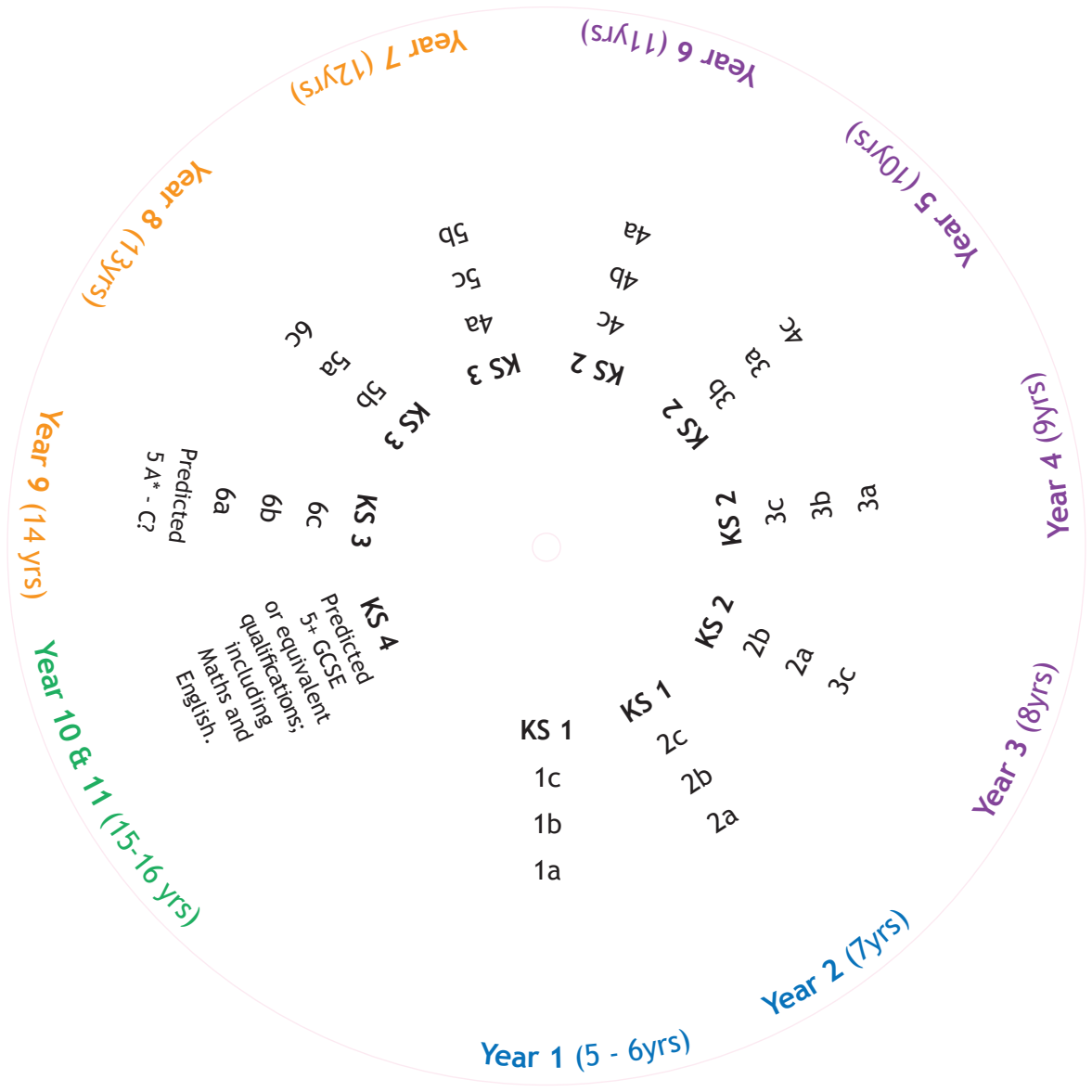
Twist to find out how your young person is doing!
