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Summary of achievement towards the key objective "To raise attainment in schools" –

In the Early Years Foundation Stage there are now no key issues and our Partnership is consistently performing in the best 5/6 in Kent

At the end of KS1 we still have a number of issues to resolve and are performing as approx 18/23 Partnerships (2009 our best 13th/lowest 21st)

At the end of KS2 we have made great improvement from the very disappointing 2008 results and are now placed overall at 9/23 (2009 our best 4th lowest 17th)
