1. Confirmation of Board Members

2. Apologies, Minutes of the last meeting and Matters Arising

Jean asked for congratulations to Herne Bay High School, Community College Whitstable and Archbishops on their results to be recorded.

3. Canterbury Coastal results summary – Lesley

Partnership Data was distributed to the group. EY, KS1 and 2 2009 results were fully discussed. At KS2 level, it was noted that cohort specific issues had affected several large

schools with poor quality marking. Appeals are currently outstanding; several schools had achieved high results and were commended on their progress.

4. Actions from last Headteachers' Meeting

Caron to contact Gordon regarding classroom programmes - Caron is contacting Steve is to follow up with Sheree about sending the list of parents to schools - Steve to check Chris is to produce a list of staff with clear lines for referrals - Chris Easton has not responded

5. General Discussion – Priorities for the year ahead and Education issues affecting Canterbury Coastal

From item 3 – it was agreed the priorities for the year ahead for Primary Schools were:

- » Raising standards particularly at KS2 in maths and writing
- » Developing APP as a workable system of assessment
- » Speaking and listening assessment
- » Developing a skills based curriculum
- » P4C (certain schools)
- » New SEF
- » Subject inspections
- » On the horizon: Record Cards, budget 2010/2011

Discussion included the possibility of common training days in 2010/11. At secondary level Claire explained that Secondary Schools tend to support themselves in terms of priorities

ACTION: *Lesley to broker support via LLN where possible or to approach consultants to set up Partnership training.
Lesley to discuss priorities with DHT group*

6. The Agenda for the next Partnership Heads' Meeting (24th September)

The agenda was agreed, Debs is to Chair.

Feedback from Primary Forum reps, Funding Forum rep and Secondary forum rep will be given at future HT meetings.

Jean outlined concerns over sustainability of the education strand of MACS from 2010/2011. Discussion centred around all Canterbury Schools supporting MACs from school budgets. Full discussion at the next HTs' meeting.

No further information is available at the present time. Lesley informed the group that the ASK brand is to go and will not be replaced by another “brand”.
