We are launching a pilot scheme of more in-depth on line training for KCC Foster carers. This training can take place from your own home and allow you to work at your own pace and in your own time.

How do Foster Carers get started?

Carers will need to express their interest with their Fostering workers as this will form part of the Personal Development Plan.

How does it work?

Carers need access to a computer with internet use and to be able to print off course materials.

Each short course has 10 or 20 learning hours and 3 months to complete each course.

- Resilience and Recovery
- Transitions and Vulnerability
- Child Development
- Working with Disabled Children & Young People
- Promoting Positive Contact
- Impulsive Behaviour
- Sexualised Behaviour
- Making Sense of Adolescence
