



## Bereavement & Loss

<b>Aims and Objectives</b>	<p>This course aims to provide practitioners with a better understanding of the impact bereavement and loss may have on both themselves and clients. We will look at the normal grief process and how this may become stuck or complicated. At the end of the course you will be able to consider the impact of bereavement and loss on clients of varied developmental stages, and consider how best to meet their needs.</p> <p>Because of the nature of this course it is not appropriate for those who have recently suffered a significant bereavement or loss to attend. This course requires participants to be reflective of their own experiences.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To provide a theoretical framework to understand the impact of bereavement and loss.</li><li>• To encourage reflective practice.</li><li>• To consider child development in relation to bereavement and loss.</li><li>• To develop confidence and ideas on what and how to help children process bereavement and loss.</li><li>• To use a variety of interventions during the course to consider the topic. This may include direct teaching, large and small group work, and experiential learning.</li></ul>
