Who for	This course is specifically for supervisors who are new to offering supervision to NQSW's only.
Aims and Objectives	Effective child care practice depends on effective management and supervision. This training workshop aims to give those with responsibility for staff supervision the opportunity to develop their supervision skills through a focus on the role of the supervisor in analysing information, managing the impact of the work and the link between supervision, style and outcomes for children.
Course Outcomes	By the end of the course participants will have been given the opportunity to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Understand the importance, and key elements of effective supervision for NQSW's- Identify the four key functions of supervision- Be clear about the stakeholders in supervision- Understand the influence of supervision histories both on the supervisor and supervisee- Recognise the impact of supervision on outcomes for children- Understand how to promote the effective analysis of information throughout the assessment and planning process- Use supervision to enable supervisees to critically appraise their practice- Be aware of how to positively manage the impact of child care work, enabling emotions to be used to enrich thinking and support safe practice- Identify blocks to learning, development, and safe practice- Develop strategies for supporting and developing staff who are blocked whilst managing situations where safe practice is compromised
