What is it?

The **Outdoor Education Advisers' Panel** (OEAP) has developed and designed a range of Outdoor Learning support resources to help educational professionals integrate outdoor learning into the curriculum.

This is a new **one day course** which will train teachers and youth workers in how to deliver exciting and inspirational outdoor learning activities using the 50 new outdoor learning cards resources.

How does it work?

The training will cover the four elements of -

- Team building and Problem Solving
- Orienteering
- Bouldering
- Journeying

These activities can be used from Foundation through to KS3. Each participant receives training and a full set of learning cards and resources.

Why is it Useful?

This programme allows leaders to –

- Experience the activities firsthand.
- Gain confidence in introducing the activities.
- Explore how the activities can be integrated within the school curriculum.
- Use in out-of-school hours learning, Extended Services and in the non-formal learning setting.
