

Ideas for Action Plan (Secondary)

Walking	Investigate the "Schools on the move" pedometer challenge for years 7&8
	Initiate a virtual race to a specified city on the other side of the world.
	Challenge another school to a virtual walking challenge.
	Produce a map showing common walking routes to school
	Set up walking groups
	Join the Step Up campaign run by Living Streets
	Consider changes to uniform, so that pupils can wear suitable shoes/ clothing for walking
Cycling	Increase cycle storage for pupils and/ or staff
	Negotiate discounts or provision of prizes with local cycle shops
	Arrange for Bike maintenance sessions
	Improve changing and/ or storage facilities for cyclists
	Provide showers for staff
	Promote cycling to school through cycling focus week/ virtual bike ride/ Go Ride programme/ bike breakfasts/ inviting in a famous cyclist
	Make cycle route maps available
	Access further cycle training
	Consider changes to uniform, so that pupils can wear suitable shoes/ clothing for cycling
	Review the schools cycling to school contract.
Public Transport	Ensure public transport information is widely available on website/ at reception/ at parents eves/ at induction events/ on a travel noticeboard/
	Set up a "Journease" travel info shop
	Ensure pupils are aware of the Kent Freedom Pass scheme
	Make pupils aware that there is a code of conduct when they are travelling
	Provide "bus buddies" for younger pupils starting at the school
	Review policy on loading of buses on the school site, and make staff aware of responsibilities
	Provide units on independent travel training (see ROSPA guidance) for students who are about to go on work experience placements, or who are travelling to other places for diploma work.

Car sharing	Designate specific car sharing spaces in the car park
	Set up database to match pupils who are prepared to car share
	Make car sharing a regular agenda item for staff meetings
	Have a "meeting free" day to enable staff to car share
	Ensure that staff consider car sharing when going to training events
Road Safety	Review curriculum to ensure units on road safety are included in the PSHE curriculum
	Liaise with KCC Road Safety team to organise Theatre in Education visits/ young driver courses.
Personal Safety	Review curriculum to ensure units on personal safety are included in the PSHE curriculum
	Invite speakers in to school to deliver sessions on personal safety
	Make personal alarms available for sale to pupils
Curriculum	Review curriculum to ensure units on the environmental effects of car travel are included in the curriculum
	Review curriculum to ensure units on the health benefits of physically active travel are included in the curriculum
	Investigate using the "Streets Ahead" pack from the RAC with KS3 pupils in geography or PSHE
Publicity and continuity	Publicise the STP on the website.
	Create a School Travel Plan summary for parents, pupils and staff
	Instigate a School Travel Plan noticeboard
	Include School Travel Plan items on the agenda for School Council or Eco team meetings.
	Publicise the STP targets and objectives at transition and parent consultation events
	Liaise with neighbouring schools to tackle problems jointly
	Subscribe to Sustrans "Routes to Action" magazines and/ or encourage pupils to write an article for Sustrans "Tracks" magazine.
Highways issues	Liaise with the parish/ borough council to raise awareness of highways issues, and then contact Kent Highway Services.
	Report parking issues to the local council parking management teams.
