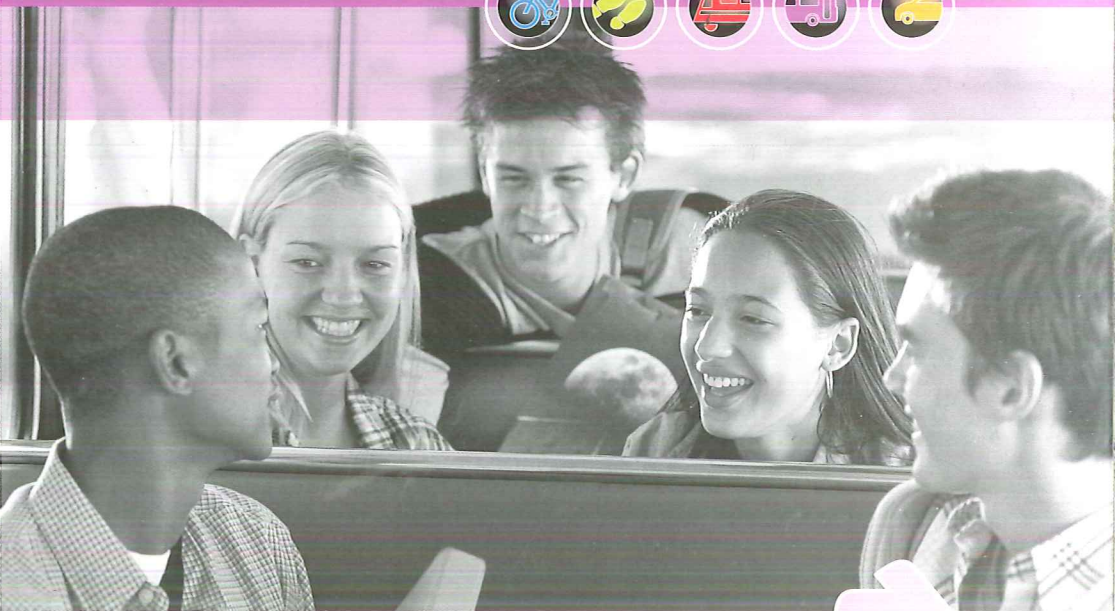

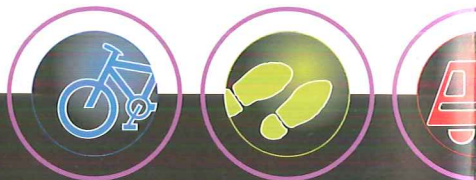
# Journease<sup>↗</sup>

The following points should give a better understanding of the Journease initiative proposed for Secondary Schools in Kent.

- **Journease** is an initiative that has been developed to help engage secondary school students in travel planning activities.
- The aim of **Journease** is to encourage independent travel for students and promote more sustainable journeys to school by way of personalised travel planning.
- Students volunteering to become **Journease** Crew should be elected from year 9+ students or from members of the School Council. KCC School Travel Plan Advisors will give appropriate training to nominated students.





Schools will need to provide a room or designated area.

**Journease** Crews will also require an online computer and printer.



KCC will provide all relevant leaflets, advertising posters, maps, timetables, cycle route information, street maps and necessary information not obtainable online.



Opening times will be as required by the school.



Some of the uses for the **Journease** initiative would be:

- Induction days: plans developed for new year 7 pupils
- Open days/evenings for parents to discuss better travel to school
- Starting a Buddy Scheme for those cycling, walking or using public transport for the first time
- Starting a school Car Share Scheme for parents, staff and students
- Helping students with after school/out of school journeys
- New route planning for those moving house
- Route planning for prospective pupils new to area
- Explaining and helping students with Kent Freedom Pass
- Receiving adverse reports regarding Public Transport use
- Travel Planning for students moving around the consortium in connection with future diploma courses.
