


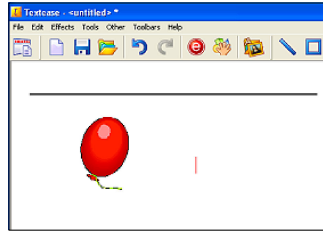
Any object can be made to move along a straight line, shape or free-hand pen line.

You need to have the *General*, *Additional* and *Graphic* toolbars displayed.

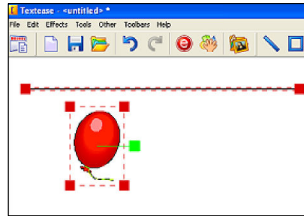
To do this click on Tool bar Control  or click on the Toolbar menu at the top of the page. Click on the toolbars needed.

How to create an Animation

1. Place an object (image or text) on the page, then draw the line you want the object to follow over.



2. Select the object to animate, then select the line it is to follow. (Select the first object as normal, then hold down the **'Ctrl'** button on your keyboard as you click on the second object.)



3. Select the **'Links'** button  to open the 'Links' window then select the 'Animate' tab.

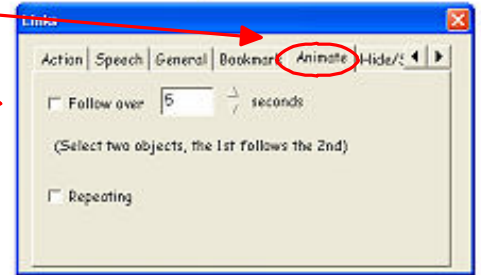


4. Click in the box to the left of the words **'Follow over'**.

5. Click in the **'seconds'** box to change the time it takes the object to follow the graphic.

6. Click in the **'Repeating'** box to make the animation continuous.

7. Click on the page to remove the red selection boxes.



To activate or stop the animation click on the object itself. Another way to stop the animation is to **press F6**.

8. To hide the line or the shape outline the object is following change the colour of the line to 'None'.

- Select the line or shape outline
- Click on Effects icon
- Select the Line colour tab
- Click in the 'None' box.
