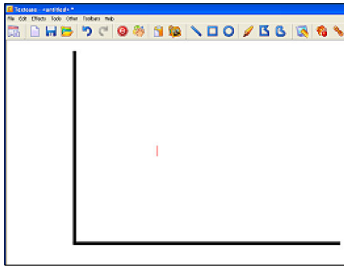
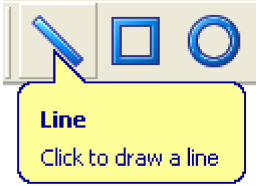


Open a Textease Studio CT page and click on the 'Toolbar control' button



Make the Vertical and Horizontal Axes

Click on the 'straight line' icon



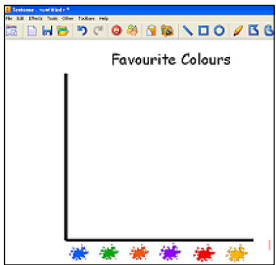
Draw a vertical line near the left hand side of the page.

Click on the 'straight line' icon again to draw the horizontal button

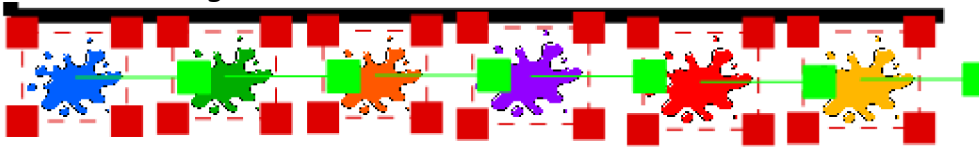
Make the lines thicker by clicking on the Effects tool and selecting style. (1.5 is a good size)

Create Icons for the pictogram that can be copied

Click on the Resource bank icon on the General toolbar.
Click and drag the images you need for your pictogram on to the page.
Resize the images and place them under the horizontal line.

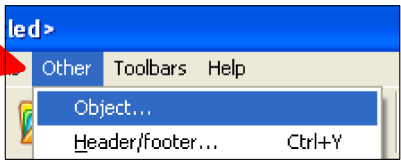
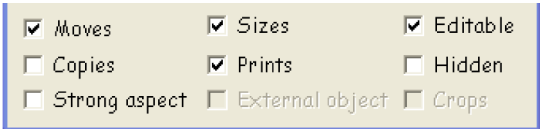


Select all the images



Click on 'Other' menu and select 'Object'

Put a tick in the square besides Copies.



Untick the Sizes square to prevent the resizing of images.

The images will not change, but it is now possible to click on each image and drag a copy of it above the horizontal line to create your pictogram

First deselect the images by clicking any where on the page.
Then click on an image and drag it above the line.
You will be dragging a copy
