

Logo commands

The following commands can be used in Logo to control the movement of the on-screen turtle:

FD	forward
BK	back
RT	right
LT	left
PU	pen up
PD	pen down
PE	pen erase
CS	clear screen
CT	clear text

Entering Logo commands

Type your sequence of commands. These can be typed in either upper or lower case. There must be a **space** between a command and the value e.g. FD 50.

You can put several commands on one line, as long as they are separated by spaces e.g. FD 50 BK 28 RT 90 LT 270.

Press Enter on your keyboard.

Using Repeat

To repeat a sequence e.g. to draw a square, the list of commands must be typed within square brackets. Type the word REPEAT followed by a space then the number of repeats. Open square brackets and everything you type within the brackets will be repeated the number of times stated. Close the brackets at the end of your repeat command.

Try the following: REPEAT 4 [FD 50 RT 90]

Press the **up arrow** on the keyboard to put old commands back on the command line. Press **Enter** to do the commands again, or use the right and left arrows to make changes.



Type PE then repeat the command by pressing the up arrow to delete something you've just drawn. Don't forget to type PD before you draw anything else!
